We reserve the right to intervene and/or remove any patron or person in the space who is creating or contributing to an unsafe environment by violating the tenets of this mandate. This applies at all times – during a performance, in the lobbies, or backstage. It is up to Imperial Theatre staff, along with the person who experienced harm, to make the decision to remove a person. This removal may pertain to a particular performance, or may extend until the violation has been addressed.

Imperial Theatre operates under a liquor licence and does not allow outside liquor, drugs or drug use in the space. We ask that if you choose to consume alcoholic beverages that you do so in a responsible manner. We reserve the right to refuse service to patrons or persons whose behaviour suggests that they are intoxicated, and may remove them at this time.
